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Summary of the Careers Programme

Bridgnorth Endowed School provides a comprehensive, impartial and progressive careers programme from Year 7 to Year 11.

The programme is aligned to the Gatsby Benchmarks and is designed to support pupils in developing aspirations, understanding the labour market, and making informed decisions about future education, training and employment pathways.

Careers education is embedded through PSHE/RSHE, assemblies, employer encounters, trips, work experience, and personalised guidance.

Information about the careers programme is published on the school website and is accessible to pupils, parents/carers, teachers and employers.

Pupils access careers learning through curriculum lessons, tutor time, assemblies and one-to-one interviews.

Parents and carers are supported through information evenings, website resources and direct contact with the Careers Leader.

Teachers are supported to link curriculum learning to careers, while employers and training providers engage through assemblies, workshops, visits, careers events and work experience in line with the Education and Training Provider Access Policy.
