

Year 11 Music Learning Outcomes

Unit 1: Composition 1 and 2

- Learners will visit information and elements required to help with the composition elements of the syllabus.
- Pupils will explore composition techniques visited on their learning journey throughout KS3 to further their skills in creating music.
- Pupils will understand how to effectively use composition tools such as DAWs, notation, communication etc.

Unit 2: Composition and Performance

- Pupils will finalise their compositions for submissions by analysing their piece of music they have created.
- During this, pupils will have added time to rehearse for their solo and group performances required in the syllabus.
- Pupils will understand how to perform on stage and how to effectively perform for a professional recording.

Unit 3: Research and Development of the Interrelated Dimensions

- During this time, Learners will develop their musical understanding as they approach their GCSE exam.
- Learning will include a recap of the interrelated dimensions required by the GCSE syllabus to allow for a successful exam.
- Also cover appraising music and analysing features within chosen extracts of music.
