Unit 1: Drawing

- Present information about your Arts inspiration to an audience.
- Research Careers in the Creative Arts industry and what courses and qualifications are required to develop skills and knowledge in further study.
- Present information of different careers of interest in a written and visual form.

Unit 5: 3D Studies

- Make a personal response informed by research.
- Understand the characteristics of building with clay.
- Understand and use slab building.
- Understand and use coil building.
- Plan a design for a functional clay piece.
- Research and write about ceramic artists or sculptors.
- Record from observation in 3-D.
- Analyse and evaluate the work of others to strengthen visual impact.

Unit 6: Presentation, Evaluation and Final Piece

- Select work to be entered for the final end of year assessment and arts awards.
- Mount and present all work into sketchbooks.
- Make clear titles to label all work.
- Annotate all work, clearly with evaluations of skills and techniques explored.
- Revisit the skills and techniques learnt through each unit to develop and complete a final piece. This can be with one chosen media or a combination to create a mixed media outcome.
