

Year 9 Music Learning Outcomes

Unit 1: Popular Music

- Pupils will discover different styles of music with the Popular music genre.
- Learners will learn about the different conventions associated with the Popular music genre through listening and appraising work.
- Pupils will work on composition and performance work in styles within the Popular music genre.

Unit 2: House Music Competition

- Pupils will work as a class to prepare a whole class performance.
- Learners will prepare and rehearse ensemble performances and solo performances.
- Some students to work on a research project as part of the competition.
- Some students to work on a composition as part of the competition.

Unit 3: Music and Media

- Learners will learn about how music is used in the media through studying adverts and themes from television.
- Pupils will compose music for various given briefs under the theme of music and media.
- Pupils will perform their compositions.

Unit 4: Film Music

- Learners will develop their knowledge and understanding of film music.
- Pupils will explore elements used to create different moods and scenes in film music through listening and appraising, composition and performance.

Unit 5: Classical Music

- Learners will learn about the classical periods and famous composers, through research and listening and appraising exercises.
- Pupils will learn to perform some pieces of classical music.
- Pupils will explore different elements used by composers and in the different genres to identify the features within the music.

Unit 6: Bridgnorth Endowed School has got talent!

- This unit will give pupils the chance to showcase the skills they have acquired through their music lessons at key stage 3.
- Pupils will perform solos and/or in groups.
- Pupils will also have the opportunity of showcasing their own compositions.
