School

We aim to provide a happy and safe environment in which all the children and staff are encouraged to develop their full potential. To aid this we will:

- Provide a safe and supportive environment for students to enjoy learning.
- Provide a broad, balanced and well taught curriculum to meet the needs of your child.
- Encourage your child to be polite, kind and considerate to others at all times.
- Set, mark and monitor appropriate homework based on our Homework Policy.
- Ensure students have the best possible education by providing high quality teaching.
- Treat students with respect and dignity.
- Provide a wide range of extra curricular opportunities and enrichment activities for students.
- Set challenging targets for students to aspire to.
- Keep you informed about your child's progress.
- Contact home to praise and reward pupils' success.
- Contact home if there are concerns about students' behaviour, effort or attendance.
- Contact home if students are to be detained for more than 30 minutes after the end of the school day.
- Provide opportunities for parents and carers to discuss pupils' progress and achievements.
- Let you know about school activities through regular communications.
- Use rewards and sanctions in order to maintain a caring and supportive environment and to commend high standards and achievements.

Parents

As part of the partnership with the school I/ we will:

- Ensure my/our child attends every day, on time, unless there are very special circumstances.
- Let the school know (in writing) the reasons for any absence.
- Not take holidays during term time.
- Ensure my/our child wears the correct uniform to, at and on the way home from school.
- Ensure my/our child has the correct learning equipment needed for the day, including their planner and their PE kit when necessary.
- Ensure my/our child attends extra support sessions that may be provided if their attendance falls below 90%.
- Provide a suitable environment for my child to work at home.
- See that my/our child completes any homework that is set, on time and sign the student planner every week.
- Attend parents' evening and any other meetings to discuss my/our child's progress and welfare.
- Ensure that my/our child follows the Bridgnorth Endowed School behaviour for learning policy.
- Support Bridgnorth Endowed School policies.
- Inform the school about any concerns or problems that may affect my/our child's work or behaviour.
- Encourage my/our child to attend additional extracurricular enrichment activities, including revision classes.
- Ensure my/our contact details are up-to-date and that they let reception staff know if their details change.

Student

I agree to help my parents and the school. I will:

- Follow the school's behaviour for learning policy.
- Be sensitive to others in and around school.
- Ensure that I work hard, to the best of my ability, on my own or with other students.
- Attend regularly, arrive on time, wearing the correct uniform and with the correct equipment, including my planner.

- Ensure that I treat all members of the school community with respect and dignity.
- Attend additional lessons that may be provided if my attendance is below 90%, to ensure progress is maintained.

- Take letters and messages home and deliver them to my parents or carers.
- Keep my planner up to date and show it to school staff, if requested.
- Avoid saying or doing anything that encourages bullying.
