

The Strategy Club

Strategy Club meets after school on Mondays 1.05 – 2.00 in room ST13 and on Fridays, 3.05 – 5.00pm. in the demountable classrooms 58 and 59.

Club members play strategic and tactical games with model figures and scenery. The games use sets of rules and are like chess, but on a much bigger and more imaginative/creative scale. Most use the Games Workshop game systems, Warhammer 40,000 and Middle Earth. However several historical war games are also played, particularly from the Ancient, Napoleonic and Second World War periods.

Games take place on large tables, typically 6 x 4 feet and use large numbers of painted figures and models as well as model trees and buildings. The rules cover movement, firing, combat and morale. Students bring their own collections of figures to use or play with a club army from Mr Clayton's large collection.

On Mondays in ST 13 students can bring their own models to build and paint. Cutters, glue, paints and brushes will all be provided. Small, quick games can also be played.

On Fridays we play the larger games in rooms 58 and 59 and these can be left out to be continued the following week if necessary. The club also makes visits to local Games Workshop stores and each year enters the Games Workshop School League in which teams from schools across the country compete at Warhammer World in Nottingham.
