School Uniform

Blazer	Navy blue with school badge
Tie	House tie
Trousers	Black, formal straight not skinny fit trousers
Skirt	Box pleated tartan checked skirt (knee length)
Shorts	(Optional summer uniform) Grey tailored shorts
Shirt	Plain white button-up shirt, long enough to be fully tucked in
Knitwear	(Optional) Navy school jumper or cardigan
Tights	Plain black tights (if socks are worn over tights, they must also be plain black)
Socks	Plain, formal socks in neutral colours
Shoes	Plain black, polishable shoes with low heels (must not have any colour or logo)
Coats	Coats to be worn over blazers not instead (no hoodies are permitted)

PE Kit

PE Top	Compulsory	Plain navy short-sleeved PE polo/ t-shirt (with school badge)
Shorts	Compulsory	Plain navy
Skort	Optional	Plain navy
Tracksuit Bottoms	Optional	Plain navy tracksuit bottoms or sport leggings (no logos)
¾ Zip Jacket	Optional	Navy school sports jacket with school logo
Socks	Compulsory	An additional pair of short white sports socks Navy football socks (for hockey, rugby, football, & orienteering)
Trainers	Compulsory	Sports style with a good supporting sole, not lifestyle trainer No Air Force or Converse footwear
Football Boots	Optional	For football & rugby team players
Shin Pads	Compulsory	For football & rugby
Mouthguard	Recommended	For hockey & rugby
Swimwear		Suitable swimming costume/swim short T-shirts can be worn during swimming if preferred

Additional Notes

Hair	Hair must be a natural colour and worn in a simple, inconspicuous style. Graded patterns or designs are not allowed.
Jewellery	Only one small stud earring in each ear is permitted and a maximum of one ring on one hand. No other body piercings are permitted. If a student has a nose piercing, a clear plastic spacer must be worn. No jewellery is to be worn during PE lessons. Badges (unless associated with school activities) are not allowed.
Makeup	Makeup is discouraged, and those wearing excessive makeup will be asked to remove it. Nail varnish and/or acrylic coloured nails are not allowed. Nails should be natural looking, with no coloured nail varnish.
Other	Tattoos are considered inappropriate. Badges (unless associated with school activities) are not allowed.

Additional guidance

- Trousers must be formal style, with straight leg and not skinny fit.
- The school tie must be tied correctly and the top button on the shirt fastened.
- School skirts must be knee length or longer.
- Boots, trainers and pumps are not allowed.
- Footwear must not have any colour or logo.
- School jumpers, cardigans or tank tops can be purchased direct from the suppliers.
- All items of clothing should be clearly marked with the owner's name.

Please note:

Pupils failing to meet the school's uniform policy will be given a detention and may be internally isolated or sent home.

Bridgnorth Endowed School shall be the sole arbiter in respect of the uniform requirements. Students who are unsure about the suitability of particular items of clothing should consult with their Head of House before purchasing, or before wearing such items to school.
