

## Year 7 French

### La Réunion (Reunion)

- Learn about the culture and geography of the French speaking island of Réunion.
- Acquire key vocabulary and grammatical structures such as expressing opinions, saying what there is and isn't and using compass points.
- Build phonic knowledge and develop sound-spelling links.

### Le Collège (School)

- How to talk about school life, including subjects and uniform.
- How to use adjectives accurately.
- Extend opinions using a range of connectives, intensifiers and opinion phrases.
- Develop the ability to ask and answer questions orally.

### La Famille (Family)

- Learn how to talk about their families.
- Build knowledge of adjectives to describe a person's appearance and personality.
- Use verbs to talk about other people.

### Le Sport (Sports)

- Learn the French for a wide range of sporting activities.
- Able to use the verbs *jouer* and *faire* accurately.
- Use a wide range of time and frequency expressions.
- Develop comprehension strategies in order to cope with more challenging texts.

### Mes Passe-temps (Free time)

- Learn to talk about other hobbies.
- Extend sentences by adding details such as where, when, who with, and an opinion.
- Recognise verbs in other tenses.
- Focus on developing written accuracy.

### La Météo (Weather)

- Learn how to discuss the weather.
- Through looking at maps of France and other French-speaking countries, develop cultural and geographical understanding.
- Produce and film a weather forecast.

### Advice to students for independent study

- Use Quizlet to revise key topic vocabulary on a regular basis.
- Learn verbs thoroughly.
- Make sure that you can give and justify opinions using a wide range of adjectives such as *rigolo*, *barbant*, *intéressant*.
- Practise using a French:English dictionary to look up new words.
