Drawing

- Use the formal elements through different drawing techniques.
- Develop knowledge and understanding of drawing for different purposes using a range of conventional and non- conventional media.
- Learn how to draw showing the direction of light and negative space to improve accuracy.

Painting

- Understand, use and develop various paint techniques.
- Explore colour theory - complementary colours.
- Analyse and evaluate own and others' work.

Printmaking

- Explore a variety of printing techniques: mono printing, lino printing, stencils.
- Research a range of artists and printmakers that use these techniques.

3-D studies

- Research, analyse and evaluate the work of several sculptors and ceramic artists.
- Experiment with a variety of media to create 3-D outcomes (clay, card, wire or Modroc).

Art History

- Research, analyse, evaluate and present information about key art movements and artists in history.

Arts Award presentation

- Review, evaluate, select and present all work as evidence for the Arts Award.

Advice to students for independent study

- Research artists and art movements.
- Collect resources and gather information in written and visual form.
- Reflect on the work and feedback from the lesson, understanding strengths and setting targets for improvement.
- Practice recording from direct observation.
