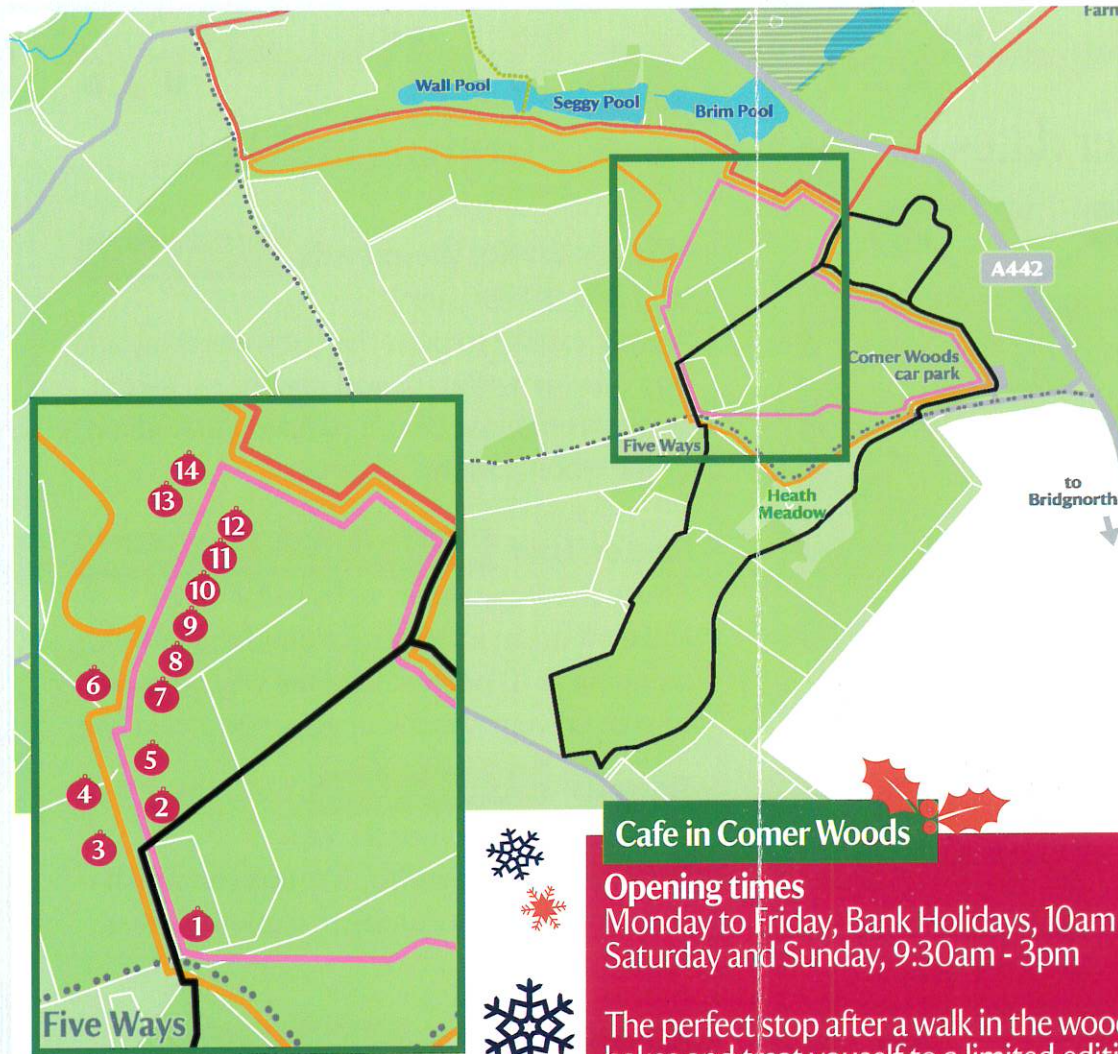
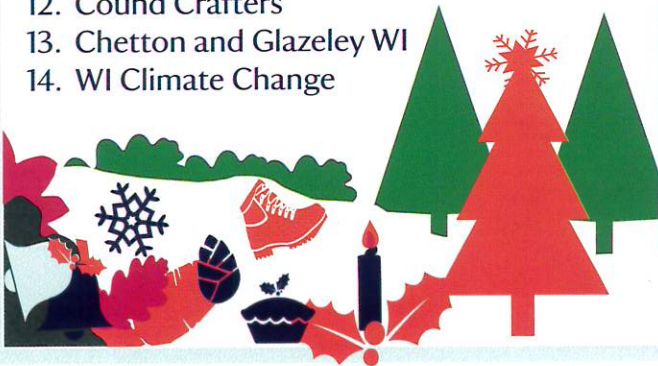


Community Christmas Tree Trail
